Flight connections

There are three different flight connections to Donostia/San Sebastián:

- San Sebastián Airport (EAS): The nearest airport, which is located directly in San Sebastián
- Bilbao Airport (BIO): Another good option that offers a wider range of international connections
- Biarritz Airport (BIQ): This airport is located in France, but is also a convenient alternative for travellers to San Sebastián.

How to get from the airport to the city centre by bus

There is a cheap bus service from **San Sebastián Airport (EAS)** to the city centre. The journey costs around €4 and takes around 35 minutes in normal traffic.

The bus company Pesa offers direct connections from **Bilbao Airport (BIO)** to the centre of San Sebastián. The buses run every hour from 07:45 to 23:45. In the direction of the airport, the buses run from 05:00 to 21:00. A ticket costs between €10 and €14.

A Flixbus runs from **Biarritz Airport (BIQ)** to the bus station in San Sebastián. The journey costs around €8-10 and takes around 1 hour and 15 minutes in normal traffic.

Expenses and meals:

You pay your own travel and accommodation costs.

In consultation with our partner, we can offer you a reduced rate for accommodation if you stay at the Hotel Arrizul Catedral (Urbietea Kalea, 51, 20006 Donostia) or the Hotel Arrizul Beach (Peña y Goñi Kalea, 1, 20002 Donostia - the hotel is directly opposite the congress hall). An overnight stay in this rate costs 89 €/night. This offer is only valid as long as rooms are available. About the Basque Country and the Basques

The Basque Country (País Vasco) is an autonomous region in the north of Spain, bordering France. With a unique history, culture and language, it is very different from the rest of Spain. The capital of the Basque Country is Vitoria-Gasteiz. The Basque Country is divided into three provinces: Guipúzcoa, Vizcaya and Álava. Donostia/San Sebastián belongs to the province of Guipúzcoa.

A total of around 2.7 million people live in the Basque Country, whose official languages are Spanish and Basque (euskera).

San Sebastián (Donostia in Basque), the capital of Guipúzcoa, is picturesquely nestled between the Urgull and Igeldo mountains. San Sebastián was the European Capital of Culture in 2016.
