The Forum of European Minority Regions is organised by the Federal Union of European Nationalities (FUEN) in cooperation with Vajdasági Magyar Szövetség (VMSZ), the Alliance of Vojvodina Hungarians.

Before travelling:

Please remember that since Serbia is not a Member States of the European Union you would need a valid passport! Please remember to bring the passport with you since they will not let you enter Serbia without it. Please reserve some time for passport control, either on departure from your home city or at the airport from which your connecting flight departs. At bigger airports there might be long queues to the non-Schengen area and an extra security control.

Arrival Day: Thursday, 26th June 2025

Departure: Saturday, 28th June 2025, around 14:00 after the concluding session and lunch

Shuttle Service Belgrade airport (BEG) - Novi Sad/Újvidék:

Novi Sad itself does not have an international airport. The nearest international airport is in Belgrade, Nikola Tesla Airport (BEG) and one hour by car. FUEN is arranging a free shuttle for all participants from Belgrade Airport (BEG) to the different hotels in Novi Sad on 26th June and back on 28th June. Please have a look further down for the different hotel options.

In order for us to know at what time we shall arrange the shuttle, we would kindly ask you to [send us an e-mail with the following information as soon as possible until 27th April 2025](#):

- your arrival and departure time
- departure airport and your flight number
- the hotel you will be staying in
- mobile phone number

The shuttle takes you to your hotel or close to the hotels in Novi Sad. We will provide you with the final schedule prior to your departure to Novi Sad/Újvidék.
